School Meal Changes



Over the coming weeks we are going to make some big changes to our administration of school dinners. Based on the comments from parents in our recent parents' survey, we commissioned a review of how school meals work in school and have identified some changes that we can make to ensure that a school meal is the best choice for our pupils. Some of the big changes will be:

- Two sittings for meals, providing sufficient time to eat a hearty school lunch, as well as more opportunity for pupils to sit in friendship groups.
- A family dining approach used within school to teach pupils about the importance of a balanced and healthy meal choice.
- More interaction between the school catering team to talk to pupils directly about their school meal.
- The setting up of a School Nutrition Action Group (SNAG) within school so that they can help to spread the message about healthy eating.
- A closer scrutiny of packed lunches to ensure that all of pupils eat healthy and nutritious food during the school day.
