Within school we are continuing to ensure that our pupils maintain good hand hygiene throughout the school day and have asked that all teachers ensure that children have the opportunity to do this regularly. This will mean that the upcoming family assemblies for Year 1 and reception will be cancelled, as will the school's Easter play and the Easter tea.
