COVID Guidelines

As mentioned in previous letters, the school will be enforcing a stricter approach to illness in school. Our key message is

- Do not send ill children into school
- If a child has a temperature above 38.1°, a new and persistent cough or issues to do with taste and smell, all children in the household must isolate and the ill child must book a test
- Let school know about the results: positive, the ill child must isolate for 10 days and the household for 14 days; negative, the pupil can return when recovered, brothers and sisters as soon as the test is negative.
