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If any member of our school community has any concern about a child, this concern can be passed to a teacher or our safeguarding team who will offer support.

If any parent has a concern about a member of staff in school, Mr Dooris should be contacted.

If any parent has a concern about Mr Dooris, Mrs Y. Joy, chair of governors, should be contacted.

These lines of communication help support the school in ensuring that if a safeguarding concern is raised, there is always someone to go to discuss that issue.
