We would like to extend a warm welcome back to all of our remote and blended learning pupils so that we can finish the term with all pupils back in school.

Since January school has been open, but only to certain pupils. From the 8th of March, all pupils are in and the routines and systems used in the autumn term are back in place to ensure that we have a safe return for all of our pupils and staff.

We have been really pleased with the way our pupils have returned, but do not underestimate the impact the three lockdowns have had on children. Work over the coming weeks and months should help to address those concerns, but if there is anything class teacher needs to be aware of please contact them.

- Please keep ill pupils away from school.
- If you or a pupil has any symptoms of coronavirus, please isolate as a household and book a test.
- Please stick as closely to the entry and exit times as possible and prevent pupils from running around the playground. If pupils have bikes or scooters, these should not be ridden out of school, but walked out to prevent bumping into other pupils or parents.
- If you have any concerns about your child/children, please speak to his/her class teacher or make an appointment to see the head teacher.
