## **Breakfast and Afterschool club**

Breakfast club will start on the 2<sup>nd</sup> of September. As with last year, all pupils can attend the free breakfast club from 8:00am to 8:45am with doors closing at 8:40am.

If parents need to access the early breakfast club this can be booked on Arbor and costs £1.70 per session payable in advance. This club starts at 7:30am.

Our after school will also start on Tuesday the 2<sup>nd</sup> of September. The club runs from 3:15pm to 5:30pm and costs £8.00 per session payable in advance. Places can be booked on Arbor up to 24 hours before the session starts.

# Nursery Timings 2025/2026



To help support parents when bringing nursery pupils into school, especially if an older sibling goes to breakfast club, the timings are changing for nursery entrance and pick up.

The new times will be:

Session 1: 8:30am to 11:30am Session 2: 12:15pm to 3:15pm All Day Sessions (for eligible pupils): 8:30am – 3:15pm



#### **School Meals**



School meals cost £2.65 for pupils in Y3 to Y6 and £2.55 for pupils in nursery. Pupils in Reception to Year 2 receive a free meal through the Universal Free School Meal scheme. All pupils can now book their meals on Arbor in advance; this is available now by logging on to Arbor, select quick actions, meals and click on the lunch menu.

If selecting meals before the 1<sup>st</sup> of September, parents need to ensure they have changed the academic year to 2025/2026 to access the menu.
