Pupils break up for the spring half term on Thursday the 19th February, with pupils returning to school on Monday the 2nd of March.

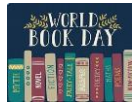


Non Uniform Day Friday

School Meals



School meals are always payable in advance, at least weekly. For pupils in Year 3 to Year 6 the current cost is £13.25 per week.

Pupils in nursery are charged at £2.55 per day, please ensure there is enough money on their account to cover the cost of meals for the following week depending on which days they attend.

You can top up your child's meals account at any time. Meal selections can be made up until the 2nd of April.

If you would like your child to move from school meals to packed lunches, or from packed lunches to school meals, please inform the school office either by email or via Arbor messages. A minimum of two weeks' notice is required.
