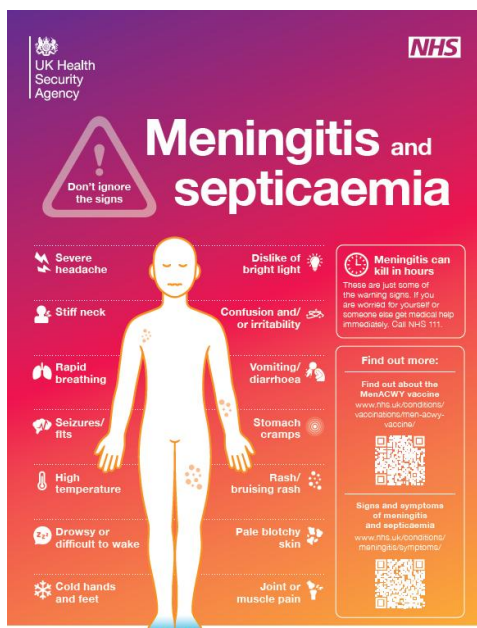


## Meningitis Awareness
