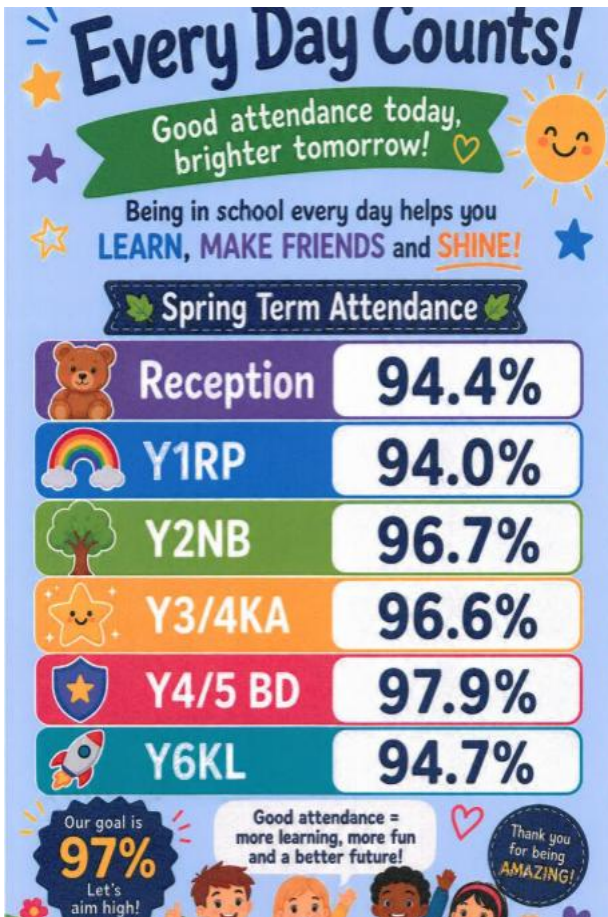
Some of our pupils, and ex pupils are involved in a stage production of Matilda, with tickets still available for purchase.
