School Vegetable Fruit Scheme Research



We're excited to let you know that we have been chosen to take part in an important school-based research project. This study is looking at the government's Free School Fruit and Vegetable Scheme (SFVS) and how it affects children's food intake. The project is being carried out by the University of Leeds and University of Northumbria, funded by the National Institute for Health Research.

A research team will visit school for 2 days collecting information from pupils, parents and teachers about how the scheme impacts on children.

The research will involve pupils from reception to year 2, with a £10 GiftPay voucher to parents who take part in the survey.

More information will be shared with parent nearer the time of the visit. This will be a great opportunity to shape the fruit and vegetable scheme for the future.

Wrap Around Care at New Marske Primary School

As well as breakfast provision, New Marske Primary offers after school care which offers care up to 5:30pm.

In addition to the free breakfast club, we have two paid provisions in school to help support our pupils and parents.

Costs for the wrap around provision are:

Early Breakfast	£1.70
Afterschool wrap around	£8.00 per session bookable up to 24 hours in advance

The after-school club takes part in a range of activities during the week including arts and crafts, baking and computing. Places at the clubs can be booked via Arbor up to 3:15pm the day before and are payable on booking.
